Form use: Do not use this form to apply for membership. To apply for membership use the 2025 NEW MEMBER APPLICATION. This form can only be used to renew your membership for 2025 between 12/1/24 and 11/30/25. Renewals received prior to 1/31/25 will not have a break in range access. Late renewals will be accepted but can take up to 2 months to be processed. **Form Instructions:** After completing and signing this form, mail the form to the address at the bottom of this page. The form can also be emailed if it is has been electronically signed or has a scanned signature. The emailed form must be a single pdf document attached to the email, Emailing a link to a form will be rejected. Emailing an image format (JPEG, TIFF, etc.) will be rejected. **Membership Dues:** <u>Annual dues are \$70</u>. Send the dues payment to the address at the bottom of this page. Make checks and money orders payable to 'Tehachapi Sportsman Club' or 'TSC'. <u>Dues payments are nonrefundable</u>.

What's new: Multiple rules have been updated, combined or renumbered. Our guest policy is updated on Rule 3: <u>Adult guests need</u> to sign a liability waiver form. Members need to sign a liability waiver for guests that are minors. See our website for waivers. **Reminders:** All members must present their current membership card to other members if requested at the gate or while on TSC property. Do not admit anyone you don't recognize at the gate without a membership card check.

Be certain you <u>know and follow the cease fire rules</u> (Rules 24 & 25). Failure to follow rules can result in fines or membership being revoked. Your membership card will include an information flyer and rule violation policy. Contact the Secretary if you observe rule violations, have policy questions, or need something clarified.

Additional Info: Club meetings are held once a month except during December. See the club website for the location and time of the monthly meetings. All members are encouraged to attend and participate in the operation and administrating our Club. The combination to the range entrance gate is changed annually at the end of February. Your membership card will have the new four-digit combination. Lock gate after entering and when leaving.

Membership is subject to adherence to basic firearm safety rules on the posted signs and the Club Rules printed on the reverse side of this form. Club Officers and Rangemasters are authorized to enforce all club rules and implement additional safety regulations at their discretion. Members not following their directions are subject to having their membership revoked.

2025 Tehachapi Sportsman Club Range Rules

- 1. Being under the influence of alcohol or mind-altering drugs is not allowed on range premises.
- 2. Everyone on the range must obey the posted basic safety rules and all club rules.
- 3. All adult guests must sign and file a liability waiver to be on TSC property. Members must sign and file a liability waiver for guests that are minors. The liability waiver is valid for one day, previous guests need to file another waiver. See the TSC website for liability waivers. All guests must be under the direct supervision of a member who must be present with the shooters at the immediate shooting station.
- 4. All firearms must be brought onto and off the range in an unloaded condition. Law enforcement officers and holders of a valid CCW permit are exempt from this rule.
- 5. Members are never permitted to give the range lock combination to anyone.
- 6. Members will clean up after using the range and will leave the range in as good or better condition than it was found.
- 7. When entering the range, be sure to raise the red flag and lock the gate. The speed limit on the range is 10 MPH.
- 8. When leaving the range, the last person to leave will lower the red flag and lock the gate.
- 9. The gate may only be left open when manned by a range master or club officer. If left open there will be a 100% check for valid membership at the gate. Check for a current membership card for anyone following you through the gate.
- 10. Bottles, cans, metallic or other non-standard targets are not allowed at any time.
- 11. Firing at rocks either on the ground or berms, or any object on the hillside is not allowed.
- 12. Do not attach targets over a vertical or horizontal supports. Use only the backboard material between the supports.
- 13. Do not place targets on the ground.
- 14. Stationary clay targets are permitted on the MPR ONLY and must be placed on the berms. Placement must be at least 4 feet from the top of the berm.
- 15. Live ammunition may not be disposed of in the trashcans.
- 16. Rifles chambered in .22LR are allowed on the pistol range. Shotguns are not allowed on the pistol or rifle ranges. Rifles and handguns are not allowed on the trap and skeet ranges
- 17. All shooters will temporarily cease fire whenever anyone is down range or on the north side of our property, from our back fence to the top of the hill beyond. Consider the range closed if this area is occupied by anyone.
- 18. The only size of shot allowed on the Trap and Skeet ranges is #7 ½ or smaller. Armor piercing, incendiary ammunition, and bullets containing any steel are not allowed to be fired on the range. Only arrows or bolts are allowed on the archery range.
- 19. Fully automatic firearms are permitted for law enforcement training only by prior approval by a vote of the membership at a regular monthly meeting.
- 20. No vandalism of any kind will be tolerated.
- 21. Any person found violating basic safety rules and/or club rules will be given a hearing by the board. This may result in fines, dismissal from the club, or loss of club privileges for a period of time deemed by the board to be appropriate to the violation.
- 22. All firearms will be pointed down range at all times.
- 23. Cross range shooting is not permitted.
- 24. Before using the pistol ranges or MPR, check for people at the 200 and 300 yard rifle ranges. Before using the MPR check for people at the 100 yard rifle range. Do not start shooting until these ranges are clear and people are back at the firing line.
- 25. A ten minute target marking period will be observed every half hour when multiple shooters occupy the range. The pistol ranges and multipurpose range must be checked and a cease fire called, before going down to the 200 and/or 300 yard targets. The multipurpose range must be checked and a cease fire called, before going down to the 100 yard rifle range targets. During a cease fire, all firing lines shall be closed and firearms must be unloaded, actions open, grounded or holstered, and no firearms will be handled. No lingering between the firing line and cease fire line during a cease fire. Upon returning to the firing line, inform all shooters that the range is open.
- 26. Be respectful of others. Criminal activity, being argumentative or disruptive, profanity, coarse or abusive language, and actions, will not be tolerated.
- 27. Members must use their own stands only at the multipurpose range, the stands must be made of wood or PVC and be at least 6 feet tall to ensure shots have the berm as a back stop. Only paper targets are allowed on the stands. Do not take stands from the pistol range to the MPR.

I hereby certify that I have read and understand the above rules. Furthermore, I agree to abide by and have all my guests abide by these rules at all times while at or using the club range. I certify that I am legally entitled to possess firearms in the State of California.
